2. Definition of Student For the purpose of this policy, a student shall be defined as any individual enrolled in a program offered by Himalaya College of Nursing.

3. Communication Protocol

c. Communications will primarily be delivered through digital means, such as email, online portals, and official college communication platforms.

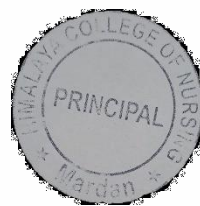
4. Student Privacy and Independence
